Veterans in the Schools 2023: Art Sladyk, Daria Plummer

- Film of wreath laying ceremony date changed to Monday, November 6th, 8 AM; gather in front of SWHS; Commission members and American Legion members invited.
- Thursday, November 9, TEMS. Format is that each 8th grade team, in four sessions, of approximately 40 students at each session (40 minutes each session), students will have questions for veterans. Student questions will be sent in advance. Memorabilia is welcomed. The format will be in a panel fashion. Veterans can make a short presentation, followed by q/a. Lunch will be served to all guests at 12:30.
- Friday, November 10th (guests visit SWHS and share ceremony school wide that was pre-filmed). Guests to gather at front foyer at 7:30 AM and will be taken to the green room. Twelve veterans needed for each period, although classes can be combined.
- Elementary School programs are set as follows: PV, Thursday, November 9, 10 AM; Friday, November 10, as follows: ET: 9 AM; OH: 9:15 AM; PRS: 9:30 AM. Commissioners encouraged to attend elementary school programs wherever they can, recognizing that both TEMS and SWHS events conflict.

Veterans Day Ceremony November 11, 2023: Ed Gawlinski

- Discussion held on location due to Pleasant Valley Road bridge repair. As work is nearing completion, Ed will evaluate on November 1st if the ceremony can be held at the Veterans Memorial Park location or if the ceremony will be held at Nevers Park Pavilion instead. He also will contact the Mayor regarding location for electronic signage information.
- Will to confirm with Park and Recreation for portolet, chairs, audio equipment, etc., once location determined. Commission has never assumed portolet cost for Veterans Day.
- Art will contact Public Works on signage, regardless of location.
