NEW BUSINESS Hemp – According to State and Federal regulations, licensed hemp plants are

legal to grow as long as their content of THC (the psychoactive component in hemp's sister strain, cannabis) remains at or below 0.3%. Though industrial hemp is used to make products such as building materials, paper, rope, textiles and nutritional supplements, its most profitable application is now the production of CBD salve, prized for its purported anxiety and pain suppressing effects. Farmer Ed Kasheta said harvesting will be done over a three week period. The

hemp will be sent out for drying and processing.

OLD BUSINESS

Sustainable CT Mayor Paterna announced that the Town is moving from Bronze to Silver Level.

Once qualified, the Town will become eligible for a \$25,000 matching grant.
