Notice is hereby given to the taxpayers in the Town of South Windsor that at a tax rate of 37.88 mills on the dollar for Real Estate, Personal Property, and Motor Vehicle was laid on the List of October 1, 2019. Real Estate and Personal Property taxes are due and payable in two equal installments, one-half due July 1, 2020 and one-half due January 1, 2021; the January 2021 installment will be attached to your July bill, additional bills will not be mailed. Any Real Estate or Personal Property tax bill of \$100.00 or less shall be due in full and payable on July 1, 2020. Motor Vehicle bills are due and payable in one installment, July 1, 2020.

In the event that the installment due on July 1, 2020 is not paid by August 3, 2020 then by law interest will be charged at the rate of 1.5% per month or fraction of a month, 18% per year from July 1, 2020. Minimum interest per state law is \$2.00. Failure to receive a tax bill shall not invalidate the tax, interest, or fees.

Only taxpayers who have applied and <u>been approved for the COVID-19 Deferment</u> will have their due dates extended from July 1, 2020 to October 1, 2020. No additional mailing will occur. In the event that the installment is not paid in full by the extended due date October 1, 2020 then by law interest will be charged at the rate noted above.

As of June 15, 2020 Town hall is closed to the public. We remain staffed Monday thru Friday 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. and are available via email taxcollector@southwindsor.org or call 860-644-2511 ext. 321. Our website and phone message will be updated should access to the office change.
