Yes No	Have you installed at least one battery-powered CO alarm or AC-powered unit with battery backup on each level of your home and near sleeping areas?
Yes No	Does a licensed professional inspect the heating systems and other fuel-
Yes No	burning appliances in your home annually? Have you made sure fuel-burning appliances are installed properly and operate according to the manufacturer's instructions?
Yes No	Do you have all fireplaces cleaned and inspected annually, and keep chimneys clear of animal nests, leaves and residue to help ensure proper ventilation?
Yes No	Have you made sure not to block or seal shut the exhaust flues or ducts used by water heaters, ranges and clothes dryers?
Yes No	Are you careful not to leave your car running in an attached garage or carport?
Yes No	Are you careful not to use ovens or stoves to heat your home?
Yes No	Are you careful not to use charcoal or gas grills inside or outdoors near a window where CO fumes could seep into your home?
