NEW BUSINESS:

Appl. 17-07P, Aldi Distribution Facility Expansion – 275 Rye St – Conservation application for an addition to an existing warehouse structure, parking, storm water controls and associated improvements on property located westerly of Rye St., Industrial (I) Zone.

Ben Wheeler from Design Professionals presented the application. Mr. Wheeler stated that this is a conservation commission application and that the project will be done in two phases. Phase 1 will consist of a 70,000 sf cooler section and Phase 2 will be a 100,000 sf section for additional dry goods storage. Some new storm water structures will be added, but the existing detention basin will not be changed. This detention basin was designed larger than needed when the original building was constructed ten years ago and will continue to be more than adequate. Standard erosion and sediment control measures will be utilized during construction.

Mr. Folger stated that the erosion and sediment controls are appropriate for the job and the site. He also stated that the property is being very well maintained.

- 1. The final approved copy of the entire set of plans and this letter reproduced thereon must be submitted to the Planning Department. This must be completed within 65 days of approval prior to any construction activity on the site. Plans submitted to Planning & Zoning Commission shall be considered having met this requirement.
- 2. The applicant shall indemnify and hold harmless the Town of South Windsor against any liability, which might result from the proposed operation or use.
- 3. The permit is valid for five years and shall expire on April 5, 2022. It is the landowner(s)/applicant(s) responsibility to track expiration dates and notify the Commission of a renewal request at least 65 days prior to expiration.
- 4. A bond shall be collected in the amount of \$10,000 to ensure proper placement and maintenance of erosion and sediment controls. The bond is to be held through the completion of both Phase 1 and Phase 2.
- 5. All approvals required must be obtained and submitted prior to any activity on the site.
- 6. A contact person shall be identified on the plans.
