Old Business

Jeff Folger handed out the new target property map. There was a discussion on plot number 15. Some felt the property would not be sold for development and therefore should be removed. Some felt the access to the river was worth keeping it on the target map.

Herb Asplund moved to remove #15 from the target property map. Louise Evans seconded. The vote was 5-4 in favor of removing the property.

Jeff Folger will remove the property and have the map ready for the May meeting of the Town Council.
