Veterans in the Schools 2023: Art Sladyk, Daria Plummer

- All programs went well.
- Will Coursey will try to get wreath laying video on our webpage, coordinating with Sara Slogesky, SWPS
- Discussion held on conflicting times with elementary school programming for Veterans Day. The goal is to have more Commission members be able to attend elementary school programs, if possible.

- SWHS will work with the Commission also will participate in the Memorial Day Parade.
- Discussion held on stopping traffic coming into and/or leaving VMP during the recitation of The Pledge of Allegiance and during Taps. It was suggested that a monitor be placed at two locations during those two brief times starting with Memorial Day.
- Discussion held on obtaining media attention for our events, both in advance and at the events. Paul will share his media contact list. Anyone with additional contacts should add to the list.
- Discussion held on having a brick location guide. Such a location guide would be put on our website.

Banner Project: Herb Asplund, Daria Plummer

- All 2023 banners now have been lowered and will be distributed to sponsors to host until May 2024 or to honorees should sponsor be unable to host. By 2024 all 2023 banners will have been returned to respective honorees.
- To date, 31 flags have sponsors. Currently, we have five honorees. Herb will resend the town listing of veterans receiving tax abatements. Commissioners asked to contact anyone they know who has not

Armed Forces Day May 18, 2024: Ed Gawlinski/Will Coursey

Memorial Day Parade May 27, 2024: Paul Mozzicato

NEW BUSINESS:

- Art presented the possibility of South Windsor hosting the Vietnam Travel Wall in 2026. If approved in May 2024 by the South Windsor American Legion Post #133, they can request South Windsor be host in July or August 2026. The wall would be set up at Nevers Road Park, be available 24-7, for a four day display. Much help will be needed and there is a cost of bringing the Wall to a locality.
