4. A narrative describing the total acreage of the site on which the animals are to be kept, nature and scope of the proposed animal(s) additions and the provisions for storage of feed, grain, hay, and animal excrements.

5. Criteria:

- Land where animals are kept is to be capable of safely supporting the number and type of animals proposed.
- Animals are to be kept for non-commercial purposes only and are to not create a hazard to themselves or the environmental quality of the neighborhood.
- Each animal should have free access to shelter in a building to provide shade and protection from wind, rain and snow. A minimum of 100 square feet of interior floor space shall be provided for each animal unit.  
 Interior floor space provided 952 sq ft
- Section 3.2.G has been complied with as it relates to proximity of structures used for the housing of animals.

- Large and medium sized animals including horses, cattle, sheep, goats and swine shall have access to exercise and living space compatible with their age and size. (minimum of 1000 sq. ft. of fenced exterior exercise area shall be provided for each animal unit.) Fences will be of sufficient height, strength, pole diameter, gage of wire, and density to assure that such animals shall not escape. Barbed wire is **NOT** allowed. Electric fencing, with signage, is permitted.
