Good Morning David,

I would greatly appreciate it if you could share the wildlife information below with the committee, as I will be unable to obtain a completed affidavit by Thursday due to a recent illness that has struck me and my family.

As background, I have lived in South Windsor my entire life, and at my current residence of [REDACTED] Edgewood Drive since 2010. Below is a record of the wildlife I have personally encountered when at my home or in our neighborhood.

9/4/2021: What I believe to be a great horned owl (based on the hooting I heard, it was 10pm and I was unable to visually identify)

8/20/2021: red tail hawk on the playscape in my yard at [REDACTED] Edgewood Drive

6/20/2021 2 deer in the open space on Edgewood Drive (2 lots away from my home and behind the applicant’s land)

10/1/2020: bald eagle flying overhead in the area of Judy Lane and Sharon Drive

9/5/2020 3 deer in the open space on Edgewood Drive

7/13/2020:

- What I believe to be a great horned owl (based on the hooting I heard, as it was 4am and I could not get a picture) in the tree in my yard at [REDACTED] Edgewood Drive
- 3 deer in my neighbor’s yard at [REDACTED] Edgewood Drive

6/8/2020: unknown turtle species in my yard at [REDACTED] Edgewood Drive

2/12/2020: red tail hawk in a tree in my yard at [REDACTED] Edgewood Drive

2/3/2020 bald eagle eating a squirrel in the tree in my yard at [REDACTED] Edgewood Drive

With the exception of the 7/13/2020 great horned owl encounter, I have either video, audio or pictures of all of the above encounters.
