Applicant proposed to clear .35 acres of wooded and brushed regulated upland area, bring in fill to raise and blend soil surface with game fields on adjacent school site and install a perimeter chain link fence to separate game fields from wetlands and remaining upland regulated area. Fill consists of soil and topsoil, and applicant requests approval of the option to install a base layer of open graded gravel below topsoil to provide a stable soil surface in the event of a rise in the seasonal groundwater elevation.

A knowing failure of the applicant or any of her/his agents to provide correct information, or performance exceeding the levels of activity anticipated, shall be sufficient grounds for revocation of any permit under these regulations.
- 4. By making this application, the applicant gives permission to the Inland Wetlands, Watercourses and Conservation Commission members and/or its representative to enter the portions of the premises which are subject of the application for the purpose of inspection and investigation and otherwise evaluating the merits of the application both before and after a final decision has been issued.
- 5. Upon approval by the authorized Agent the applicant shall cause notice of the decision to be published in a daily newspaper having a general circulation in the Town where the activity occurs. The notice must be published within ten (10) days of the decision.
- 6. Appeals of this decision may be brought to the Agency within fifteen (15) days after the publication date of the notice.
