**E. Resolution Establishing an Energy Committee**

WHEREAS, it is the best interest of the Town of South Windsor and its citizens to actively pursue feasible means of lowering energy consumption and costs; and

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Town to reduce its dependence on fossil fuels in the functioning of all Town facilities; and

WHEREAS, it is found that the most expeditious and appropriate means of gathering the information necessary to inform the Town and its citizens about energy conservation and clean and renewable energy options is through a committee charged with that duty; and

WHEREAS, it is determined that it is in the best interests of the Town that the Energy Committee be formed pursuant to the following:

1. The Committee shall consist of seven (7) members who shall be appointed by the Town Council. The members of the Committee shall include at least one member of the Town Council, the Director of Public Works, the Superintendent of Schools or the Superintendent of Schools designee, and four (4) additional members of the public representing diverse interests as property and/or business owners, at least one of which also shall be experienced in the fields of energy management, clean energy, renewable energy, public outreach, architecture, building construction, or building trades; and
2. The Energy Committee shall select a Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson and Secretary at its first meeting following the start of the calendar year; and
3. The Energy Committee shall have the following duties and responsibilities:
  - a. Investigate appropriate and cost-effective opportunities for implementing energy efficiency measures in all aspects of South Windsor's public buildings, including operational changes and changes in maintenance or capital improvements. These recommendations shall be forwarded to the Town Council or appropriate municipal agency or official as designated by the Town Council.
  - b. Research and facilitate the use of clean, renewable energy within the Town of South Windsor.
  - c. Educate South Windsor residents about clean energy options, energy efficiency, and energy conservation.

- d. Identify appropriate Federal and State incentive and grant programs that provide opportunities for clean, renewable energy, energy efficiency, or energy conservation.
- e. Take advantage of unique opportunities and resources within South Windsor for providing clean, renewable energy to help fulfill local energy needs.
- f. The Energy Committee shall serve in any advisory capacity only and its recommendations shall not bind the Town to take any specific action or require that it appropriate any funds.
- g. All meetings and records of the Committee shall be in compliance with applicable state statutes. A status report shall be provided by the Committee to the Town Council no later than December 30<sup>th</sup> of each year or as may be directed by the Town Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town of South Windsor hereby establishes the foregoing Energy Committee to provide advice to the Town Council regarding ways to promote clean power options, encourage the development of renewable energy in South Windsor, and make recommendations for energy conservation, all in accordance with the duties and responsibilities set forth herein.

We are seeking to enter into Contract #2068-09-10-2020 with the Town of Vernon to haul the leaves that they collect in the Town of Vernon to our leaf site here in South Windsor. The Town of South Windsor will then turn the leaves into compost and increase our available inventory of compost for sale. The Town of South Windsor has won the competitive bid process that Vernon advertised and executed on 9-10-2020 contract number 2068. Vernon will **pay** South Windsor \$2.62 a cubic yard to remove the leaves from their (3) stockpiled locations (South Windsor **WILL NOT BE PERFORMING CURB SIDE PICKUP** in the Town of Vernon). South Windsor intends to either self-perform the hauling or utilize one of the town trailer contracts available to us.

Entering into this contract with the Town of Vernon is in line with the Compost Facility Expansion Plan which was submitted to the Town Council in May of 2019 and will further allow the Town of South Windsor to develop this plan and eventually reduce the tax burden of the curb side leaf pick up program in South Windsor.

- (3) We Encourage all citizens of South Windsor to join in activities in support of the goals and ideals of Race Amity Day
- (4) We Authorize and issue this Resolution calling on the people of the Town of South Windsor, in the State of Connecticut, to observe Connecticut Race Amity Day with appropriate programs and activities.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the *South Windsor Town Council on behalf of the residents of South Windsor, do hereby declare the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in June each year as Race Amity Day in South Windsor* and the South Windsor Town Council stands firmly committed to Peace, Justice, Freedom, and the establishment of an anti-racist culture in South Windsor.
