Updated Information for the August 11, 2020 Primary – Registered Democrats & Republicans Absentee Ballot Mailing Delayed Ballot Box Installed at South Windsor Town Hall

The mailing of Absentee Ballots *for those who submitted an application* for the August 11, 2020 Primary was originally scheduled to begin July 21st. However, we were notified by the Secretary of State's office that the first batch of ballots was not mailed until July 27th. Therefore, if you applied for an Absentee Ballot for the August 11, 2020 Primary, you should be receiving your ballot soon.

You will receive a postage-paid envelope to return your ballot via the U.S. mail. However, given the large volume of mail being processed through the U.S. Postal Service, we are highly encouraging voters to use the newly-installed Official Ballot Drop Box located outside Town Hall to ensure we receive your ballot in a timely manner.

All Absentee Ballots must be received by the Town Clerk's office on Primary Day, August 11, 2020 by 8:00 p.m. for the ballots to be counted.

Please note that if you choose not to vote by Absentee Ballot, <u>voting at the polls will be available</u> on August 11th from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
