## **Buckland Road Pavement Rehabilitation**

The Town has hired Palmer Paving to restore approximately 4,900 feet of pavement on Buckland Road from the Manchester town line through the intersection at Deming Street, with an anticipated start date of August 4<sup>th</sup>. The initial work will include construction staking and layout, installation of erosion control, the removal and replacement of curbing in select areas, followed by the adjustment of existing drainage structures. Milling of Buckland Road is scheduled to begin the week of August 14<sup>th</sup>, and because of the high volume of traffic the milling and paving will be completed during nighttime hours (8:00 P.M. to 6:00 A.M). Following the paving, pavement markings will be applied, and any disturbed lawn areas due to construction will be restored. We anticipate this project to be completed during the first week in September.

Buckland Road will remain open during construction, however expect uneven pavement, delays, and change in traffic patterns. Driveway access will be maintained throughout the project. Motorists are advised to seek alternate routes around Buckland Road during this work if possible. We appreciate your patience during construction.
