2018 Pension Valuations by Milliman

Please find enclosed the 2018 Pension Valuations Report done by Milliman. There are some very telling issues in some of the graphs, which I will explain in more detail during the Town Council meeting. I think it is good news for South Windsor, and I think it should be highlighted as the Pension Committee has worked very hard to ensure that the Town's pension plans are intact.

460 Miller Road

The case was tried last week. We are awaiting the judge's decision. I cannot tell you when a decision will be made, but hopefully it will be soon so that we can move forward and resolve this issue once and for all.

Plastic Bag Elimination

The Town Attorney has been sent some information on the elimination of single-use plastic bags in the Town of South Windsor. He will be working with Heather Oatis from the Health Department, who has been reviewing and has been ahead of this issue. As soon as we get something back from the Town Attorney we will be able to put a public hearing together and have some meaningful discussions with the Town Council.

Porter's Hill

I know that there has been a committee put together to look into putting up a sign for Porter's Hill on the sledding hill. This sign will be made by the Town's Sign Department. It will be put up in the spring, once the ground is no longer frozen.
