- Bike Walk Connecticut March newsletter:
  - Senate Bill [SB 980] Governor Lamont's budget includes \$10 million (\$5 million/year) for Recreational Trails & Greenways program grants. Contact your legislators in support of this senate bill.
  - Women Don't Cycle film on April 15 BiCi Co West will host the first public screening in the US of this new documentary film by Manon Brunard, who explores what it means to be a woman cycling in different countries around the world.
