BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Council hereby directs Town Manager Mathew B. Galligan to execute said tax fixing agreement on behalf of the Town of South Windsor.

CC. Resolution Setting a Time and Place for a Public Hearing to Receive Citizen Input on an Amendment to Ordinance #141, Agricultural Land Preservation Advisory Commission

BE IT RESOLVED that the South Windsor Town Council hereby sets Monday, December 18, 2017, at 8:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers of the South Windsor Town Hall, 1540 Sullivan Avenue, South Windsor, Connecticut as the time and place for a Public Hearing to receive citizen input on an Amendment to Ordinance #141, Agricultural Land Preservation Advisory Commission.

After a lengthy discussion, the Council requested that a redlined version be provided to the Council, and the references be taken out of the Ordinance. There was a suggestion that the Council wait to discuss this Commission when all of the Boards and Commissions are being reviewed and discussed. There were also concerns expressed about having five members making up a quorum when it is defined as 50% of the membership plus one. The membership of the Commission is another area that should also be reviewed.

Councilor Pendleton withdrew her motion; and Councilor Maneeley withdrew her second.

Deputy Mayor Paterna made a motion to suspend the rules in order to go to Item 15. DD. on the agenda. Councilor Riley seconded the motion; and it was approved, unanimously.

DD. Resolution Creating a Temporary Task Force to Enhance Commission and Committee Functionality in South Windsor

WHEREAS, the Council is responsible to appoint members to a number of Boards and Commissions; and

WHEREAS, each Board and Commission requires attendance at meetings by at least a quorum of its members; and

WHEREAS, each Board and Commission and its members must comply with the requirements of the Freedom of Information Act; and

WHEREAS, each Board and Commission should adopt rules, regulations and/or by-laws regarding the conduct of meetings, voting, participation at meetings, and similar provisions; and

WHEREAS, each Board and Commission should regularly communicate with and report to the Council regarding its meetings and activities

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the South Windsor Town Council supports the creation of a Temporary Task Force to investigate, study, and make recommendations regarding the aforesaid responsibilities and expectations, and to prepare a report of its findings to be presented to the Council and the public by January 12, 2018; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Task Force be voluntarily composed of equal numbers of members of the Democratic and Republican Parties, with volunteers from the Council, both Town Committees, and to the extent possible, members from each Board and Commission, the total number of members not to exceed (8), plus the Town Manager, or his designee, if the Manager consents to serve, and that there be no more than three meetings of the Task Force.

Was made by Councilor Glickman Seconded by Councilor Pendleton

Council members discussed the amount of meetings being proposed and the date when the finding of the Committee is supposed to be presented to the Council and the public. Councilor Riley felt that if there are Commissions or Boards that have overlapping duties then the Commissions and Boards could be combined.

Councilor Riley made a friendly amendment to paragraph 6, to have it read, "NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the South Windsor Town Council supports the creation of a Temporary Task Force to investigate, study, and make recommendations regarding the aforesaid responsibilities and expectations, and to prepare a report of its findings including the necessity of each Board and Commission and the recommendation with respect to the elimination of any overlap in mission to be presented to the Council and the public by January 12, 2018". Councilor Glickman and Councilor Pendleton stated they both would accept the friendly amendment.

Councilor Pendleton voiced concern that the membership would exceed the number of eight members that are being proposed.

Councilor Glickman made a motion to move the question. It was seconded by Mayor Anwar. The motion passed on a roll call vote of 4 to 5 with Mayor Anwar, Deputy Mayor Paterna, Councilor Glickman, Councilor Hockenberry, Councilor Maneeley, Councilor Mirek, and Councilor Riley voting in favor to call the question; and Councilor Pendleton and Councilor Snyder voting in opposition to call the question.

Mayor Anwar called for a vote on the amended motion; it failed on a roll call vote of 4 to 5 with Mayor Anwar, Deputy Mayor Paterna, Councilor Glickman, and Councilor Riley voting in favor of approval; and Councilor Hockenberry, Councilor Maneeley, Councilor Mirek, Councilor Pendleton, and Councilor Snyder voting in opposition of approval.

At 10:35 p.m. Deputy Mayor Paterna made a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss a personnel issue and all pending claims and litigation. Councilor Snyder seconded the motion; and it was approved, unanimously.
