

PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES

February 18, 2020

8:00 p.m.

South Windsor Town Council

PURPOSE: To Receive Citizen Input on the Transfer of Excess FEMA Grant Proceeds to Current Referendum Projects.

Mayor Paterna called the Public Hearing to order at 8:00 p.m.; and requested that the Clerk of the Council read the call of the meeting (a copy of which is attached hereto, **Exhibit A**). There were approximately twenty-five (25) people present in the audience.

Mr. Maniscalco explained that in the past, the Town of South Windsor experienced a disaster in relation to Storm Alfred. In the process, the Town decided to bond funds to help with clean-up efforts and was then reimbursed by FEMA. The funds from FEMA and funds that were expended did not equal the total amount that was bonded. There are excess proceeds in the amount of approximately \$610,618, which will be reallocated to the bonded funds for the two current school construction projects rather than giving them back.

Mayor Paterna asked if there was anyone from the public that would like to speak, there was none.

Mayor Paterna called for a Straw Vote, the results of which were as follows:

Those supporting to transfer the excess FEMA Grant proceeds to current referendum projects: 7

Those opposed to transferring the excess FEMA Grant proceeds to current referendum projects: 0

The public hearing was closed at 8:05 p.m.
