DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY


WHEREAS, the Town of South Windsor has been impacted by two severe thunderstorms over a 48 hour period bringing 60 mile per hour gusts with upwards of two thousand customers without electricity during each instance;

WHEREAS, the Town of South Windsor weather reports are predicting a potentially strong thunderstorm for this evening and it is expected that the State of Connecticut will be impacted by Tropical Storm Elsa in the morning of July 9, 2021;

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Connecticut has ordered the State Emergency Operations Center open at 6am July 9, 2021;


WHEREAS, the Town of South Windsor Charter and Code of Ordinance Section 26-5 (2) identifies the Town Manager as the authority to declare a State of Emergency in the event of an emergency affecting the health, safety and welfare of residents in the Town of South Windsor.

BE IT DECLARED that the Town of South Windsor is under a State of Emergency until this threat is mitigated and will be taking every effort to ensure the health safety and welfare of all residents.
