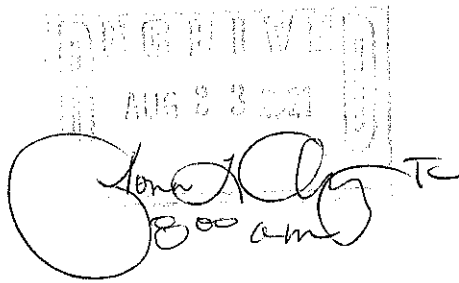

DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Town of South Windsor is in the direct path of hurricane Henri with expected impact for approximately 10am EST.;

WHEREAS, the Town of South Windsor weather reports are predicting a potential for winds in the 40-50mph range with hurricane Henri already producing winds upward of 70 mph;

WHEREAS, the Town of South Windsor weather reports are predicting a potential for rain fall of up to 5 inches;

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Connecticut has ordered the State Emergency Operations Center open at 10am August 22, 2021;

WHEREAS, the Town of South Windsor Charter and Code of Ordinance Section 26-5 (2) identifies the Town Manager as the authority to declare a State of Emergency in the event of an emergency affecting the health, safety and welfare of residents in the Town of South Windsor.

BE IT DECLARED that the Town of South Windsor is under a State of Emergency until damage from the hurricane Henri is mitigated.

FURTHERMORE BE IT DECLARED, that the Town of South Windsor will be taking every effort to ensure the health safety and welfare of all residents.
