COVID-19 Update

As of the time of this report the Town of South Windsor is reporting a total of 219 confirmed cases of COVID-19. This is a comprehensive count of all cases since monitoring began. Of this number, 182 are past quarantine and 32 have passed away. This week Governor Lamont has released a new executive order granting municipalities the authority to fine people for not wearing a mask and ignoring gathering limit sizes.

Chief of Police Search

By the time of the Council meeting I will have announced who our next Chief of Police will be. We will be planning a pinning ceremony as well as working on safe methods for the community to meet with our new Chief.

ICMA Conference

This year's conference will be virtual and will take place from September 23- September 26th. I plan to attend the conference virtually through those days in order to get the work done that I will need to maintain my credentialed manager certification. As a reminder this certification requires 40 hours per year of continuing education that is peer reviewed. There are only 1,419 credentialed managers internationally.
