Police Department Hosting National Night Out: The Police Department is tentatively planning a National Night Out event at Nevers Road Park for August 1, 2023. The event will have a truck, ice cream, food, bounce house, music and giveaways. The purpose of the event is to provide our community, and in particular, our youth the opportunity to get to know our Police Department and officers so that we can all be better partners at keeping our community safe.

Splash Pad Construction: All of the equipment and permits are set at the site. Aqua Turf, the subcontractor for the splash pad construction, has had delays getting onsite. They were originally scheduled to arrive on site mid-May and has been rescheduling the start date due to various personal reasons. We do have the contractor now scheduled to be on-site Friday, June 16th.

Summer Camp Preparation: Since the Parks and Recreation Department's move to the Old Orchard Hill facility at the end of April, the department along with Building Maintenance and Information Technology, have been actively working to make the space function. Some of the preparation work for camp include: deep cleaning and painting the rooms, repainting the gym floor lines, moving all the camp equipment and setting it up in the new space, installation of the ADA entrance, new bathroom and building signage, installation of air conditioning units and repairs to the playground space. The camp staff had training during the week of June 3rd and are excited to welcome youth to summer camp starting on Monday, June 19th for the pre-camp week!
