COVID-19 Update

I will have updated numbers for you at the time of the Council meeting. Town staff have started up the vaccination clinic at Evergreen Walk again. Additionally, we are working on preparing to offer booster shots as well. As this process progresses, I will make sure all the information is provided to the Town Council and the public.

Eversource Meeting

Last week, I had the opportunity to meet Tim Adams who is the Government Relations Executive from Eversource. We had the opportunity to show him our Emergency Operations Center and discuss how we operate during a disaster. We were also able to make suggestions and collaborate on how we can work together. Eversource is in the process of rolling out new software that will help them and the municipality organize restoration and provide better information to the public. On September 15th, the Town and Eversource hosted other regional Towns at a training session on the software.

Yard Signs

With campaign season upon us, we are seeing many more lawn signs going up. First, I want to make sure that any political signs are not to be placed on public property. If they are, the Town will remove them and hold them for you to pick up. Second, it is important that everyone remembers that these signs are private property, and it is a crime to remove and/or deface a sign that is not yours, and not on your property. We have had reports to the Police Department of this kind of activity already, and it will not be tolerated.

Laurel Street

Just to recap, the Town has ordered the signs after the Internal Traffic Committee approved the recommendation. We are approximately seven weeks out from the delivery date at this point. Once they are delivered, Town staff will work to get them installed as soon as possible.
