### SCHOOL OUTREACH CORNER...

#### **SWHS Students Against Destructive Decisions (SADD) Club**

The Club, which has about 75 students, organizes prevention activities throughout the year. In Nov/Dec they focused on 3 important projects.

- 1. They held a **SOCK DRIVE** asking students and staff to donate socks (or money to purchase socks) for people in local homeless shelters. Socks are often the #1 needed item for people of all ages. They **collected 246**pairs of socks to donate!

- 2. They also worked on the <u>LIQUOR STORE PROJECT</u>.

  A sub-committee reached out to local liquor stores asking for permission to decorate bags with messages about being safe this holiday season. Then the entire club **decorated hundreds of bags**. The messages included reminders about not drinking and driving, not giving alcohol to minors and staying smart each time they get in the car. The activity is a great community service project for the group.

- 3. They organized <u>SADD MAKES YOU HAPPY DAY</u> at SWHS. This day was created by the group about 4 years ago as a way to honor those who lost their lives at Sandy Hook. Each year on Dec. 14<sup>th</sup>, the students choose to show kindness and caring to all staff and students. They baked lots of homemade treats for the staff, gave flowers to the cafeteria staff, wrote positive affirmation sticky notes for people to take, handed out candy canes and hid secret bags of money.
